# The Combined Probation and After-Care Areas (Cambridgeshire) Order 1982

Made

15th December 1982

Coming into Operation

1st January 1983

In exercise of the powers conferred upon me by section 54(4) of, and paragraph 1 of Schedule 3 to, the Powers of Criminal Courts Act 1973(a) (as extended by Article 3 of the Combined Probation and After-Care Areas Order 1974(b)) and after the consultation required by that paragraph, I hereby make the following Order:—

- 1. This Order may be cited as the Combined Probation and After-Care Areas (Cambridgeshire) Order 1982 and shall come into operation on 1st January 1983.
- 2. That part of Schedule 2 to the Combined Probation and After-Care Areas Order 1974(c) which relates to the Cambridgeshire Probation and After-Care Committee shall be amended by omitting the entries in respect of the petty sessions areas of Cambridge City and South Cambridgeshire and inserting in alphabetical order in column 1 "Cambridge" and corresponding to this in column 3 "5".
- 3. The five justices appointed to be members of the Cambridgeshire Probation and After-Care Committee by the justices for the petty sessional divisions of Cambridge City and South Cambridgeshire before those divisions were combined to form a new division known as the Cambridge division shall continue to hold office as members of that committee, as if they had been appointed by the justices for the new division, until 30th November 1983 and shall then cease to hold office, but shall be eligible for re-appointment.
