CHANGES IN LOCAL GOVERNMENT AREAS

The North Yorkshire and West Yorkshire (Areas) Order 1982

Made - - - - 14th December 1982

Laid before Parliament 6th January 1983

Coming into Operation—

for the purposes

described in article 2

1st February 1983

for all other purposes

1st April 1983

Whereas the Local Government Boundary Commission for England, under sections 47 and 51(1) of the Local Government Act 1972(a), on 24th July 1981, made proposals to the Secretary of State for the Environment for the transfer of part of the County of West Yorkshire to the County of North Yorkshire;

Now therefore the Secretary of State for the Environment, in exercise of his powers under sections 51(2) and 67(4) of the said Act and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following order:—

Title and commencement

1. This order may be cited as the North Yorkshire and West Yorkshire (Areas) Order 1982.

2. 1st February 1983 is hereby specified as the day on which this order shall come into operation for any purposes set out in regulation 4(1) (Coming into operation of order) of the Regulations.

For all other purposes this order shall come into operation on the appointed day.

Interpretation

3. In this order—

“the appointed day” means 1st April 1983; and

“the Regulations” means the Local Government Area Changes Regulations 1976(a) as amended by the Local Government Area Changes (Amendment) Regulations 1978(b).

Changes in areas

4. That part of the County of West Yorkshire and of the City of Bradford which comprises the Parish of Kildwick shall be transferred to the County of North Yorkshire and to the District of Craven and shall form part of the Skipton Rural No. 1 electoral division of the County of North Yorkshire, of the Aire Valley ward of the District of Craven, of the Staincliffe petty sessional division and of the Claro coroner's district.

Land registration

5. Registration of title to land under the Land Registration Acts 1925 to 1971(c) shall remain compulsory on sale in the Parish of Kildwick.

Town and country planning

6. The provisions applicable to the area transferred by article 4 of—

- (i) the structure plan;
- (ii) the old development plan (within the meaning of paragraph 2 of Schedule 7 to the Town and Country Planning Act 1971(d));
- (iii) any local plan which has been adopted by the County Council of West Yorkshire; and
- (iv) any local plan which has been adopted by the City Council of Bradford

shall have effect as if they were—

- (a) in the case of (i) or (ii), contained in similar plans made by the County Council of North Yorkshire;
- (b) in the case of (iii), a local plan adopted by such council; and
- (c) in the case of (iv), a local plan adopted by the District Council of Craven.

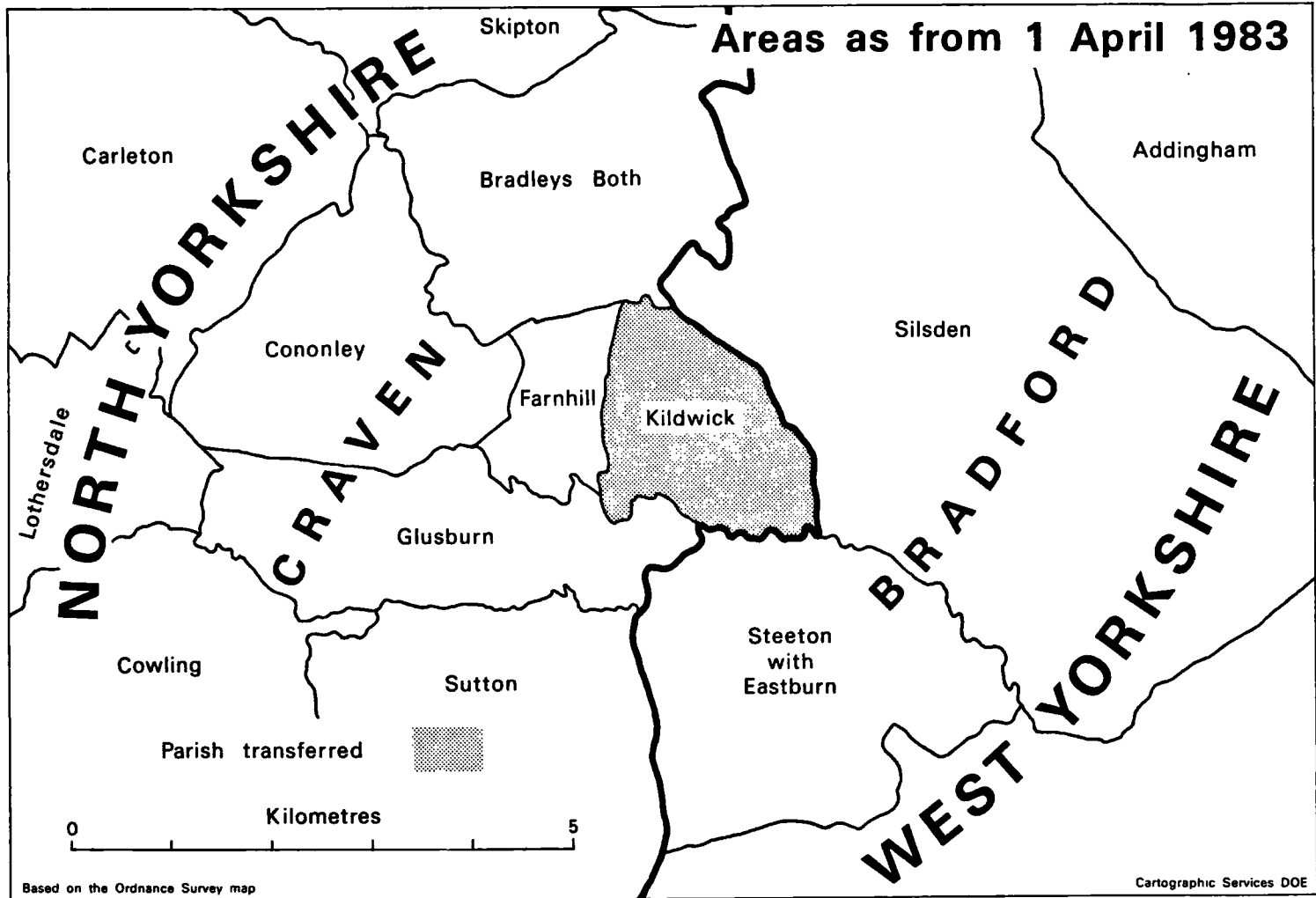
EXPLANATORY NOTE
