Whereas the Local Government Boundary Commission for England, under sections 47 and 51(1) of the Local Government Act 1972(a), on 1st July 1981, made proposals to the Secretary of State for the Environment for the transfer of part of the Borough of Swale to the Borough of Gillingham:

Now therefore the Secretary of State for the Environment, in exercise of his powers under sections 51(2) and 67(4) of the said Act and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following order giving effect to the said proposals with a modification:—

### Title and commencement

- 1. This order may be cited as the Gillingham and Swale (Areas) Order 1982.
- 2. 1st February 1983 is hereby specified as the day on which this order shall come into operation for any purposes set out in regulation 4(1) (Coming into operation of order) of the Regulations.

For all other purposes this order shall come into operation on the appointed day.

### Interpretation

3. In this order—

"the appointed day" means 1st April 1983;

"the boundary map" means the map issued by the Department of the

Environment as "Map referred to in the Gillingham and Swale (Areas) Order 1982": and

"the Regulations" means the Local Government Area Changes Regulations 1976(a) as amended by the Local Government Area Changes (Amendment) Regulations 1978(b).

### Changes in areas

- 4. That part of the Borough of Swale and of the Parish of Upchurch which is shown hatched black on the boundary map shall—
  - (a) be transferred to the Borough of Gillingham;
  - (b) form part of the Gillingham North East electoral division of the County of Kent, of the Riverside ward of the Borough of Gillingham and of the Medway petty sessional division; and
  - (c) cease to form part of any parish.

(This Note is not part of the Order.)


This order transfers part of the Parish of Upchurch from the Borough of Swale to the Borough of Gillingham. The area transferred has approximately an area of 6 hectares, a population of 10 and an estimated rateable value of £2,520. It is shown on the map forming part of this note.
