The Rate Support Grant (Repeal of Enactments) Order 1982

Made - - - 9th February 1982

In exercise of the power conferred on the Secretary of State by section 53(10) of the Local Government, Planning and Land Act 1980(a), I hereby make the following Order:—

- 1. This Order may be cited as the Rate Support Grant (Repeal of Enactments) Order 1982.
- 2. It is hereby directed that section 5(2) of the Local Government Act 1974(b) (power to prescribe standards and general requirements in relation to local authority functions) shall cease to have effect on 1st May 1982.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Order.)

Section 5 of the Local Government Act 1974 makes provision for the reduction of rate support grant under that Act where a local authority fail to achieve a reasonable standard in the discharge of their functions. For the purpose of determining this, regard is to be had to any standards and general requirements prescribed by regulations under section 5(2).

The only such regulations in force are revoked by the Education (Teachers) Regulations 1982 (S.I. 1982/106), which come into operation on 8th April 1982 and the Order provides that section 5(2) shall cease to have effect on 1st May 1982.
