**WATER, ENGLAND AND WALES**

**The Anglian Water Authority (Middle Warren) Order 1982**

*Made* - - - - - 13th January 1982

*Coming into Operation* 1st February 1982

The Secretary of State for the Environment, in exercise of his powers under section 23 of the Water Act 1945(a) and now vested in him(b), and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby orders as follows:

1.—(1) This order may be cited as the Anglian Water Authority (Middle Warren) Order 1982 and shall come into operation on 1st February 1982. Citation and commencement.

(2) The Anglian Water Authority Act and Orders 1974 to 1977, the orders made by the Anglian Water Authority and set out in the Schedule to this order and this order may be cited together as the Anglian Water Authority Act and Orders 1974 to 1982.

2. In this order, unless the context otherwise requires: Interpretation.

“the Authority” means Anglian Water Authority;

“the deposited plan” means the plan prepared in duplicate, signed by an Under Secretary in the Department of the Environment and marked “Plan referred to in the Anglian Water Authority (Middle Warren) Water Order 1982”, one duplicate of which has been deposited and is available for inspection at the offices of the Authority at Yare House, 62/64 Thorpe Road, Norwich, Norfolk and the other in the offices of the Secretary of State for the Environment;

“the Third Schedule” means the Third Schedule to the Water Act 1945;

“the undertaking” means the undertaking of the Authority as from time to time authorised by any enactment.

3. (1) The Authority may acquire by agreement and thereafter continue and maintain the mains, pipes and apparatus the approximate positions of which are shown by red lines on the deposited plan. Power to acquire by agreement, continue and maintain works.

(2) The said mains, pipes and apparatus when acquired by the Authority shall for all purposes form part of the undertaking and for the purposes of the Third Schedule as applied to the undertaking shall be deemed to have been laid or constructed by the Authority for the purpose of giving a general supply of water.

4. Section 94 of the Third Schedule shall apply to the undertaking and is hereby incorporated with this order, subject to the modification that in sub-section (1) thereof for the words from "with the clerk of the council" to the end of the sub-section there shall be substituted the words "with the council of every county and district affected by the special Act".
