The Severn Bridge (Amendment) Regulations 1982

<i>Made</i> - - - - -	9th March 1982
<i>Laid before Parliament</i>	22nd March 1982
<i>Coming into operation</i>	30th April 1982

The Secretary of State for Transport, in exercise of powers conferred by section 7(5) of the Severn Bridge Tolls Act 1965(a), and now vested in him(b), and of all other enabling powers, hereby makes the following Regulations:—

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Severn Bridge (Amendment) Regulations 1982, and shall come into operation on 30th April 1982.

2. The Severn Bridge Regulations 1966(c), shall be further amended by substituting in paragraph (6) of Regulation 12 (which relates to charges for the removal of vehicles) for the words “£8 for the first half hour or part of an half hour taken and £2 for each quarter of an hour or part of a quarter of an hour taken after the first half hour” the words “£12 for the first half hour or part of an half hour taken and £6 for each quarter of an hour or part of a quarter of an hour taken after the first half hour”.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Regulations.)

These Regulations increase the charges to be paid under Regulation 12 of the Severn Bridge Regulations 1966 for the removal, repair or adjustment of a broken down vehicle from £8 for the first half hour or part thereof to £12 for the first half hour or part thereof and from £2 for each quarter hour or part thereof taken after the first half hour to £6 for each quarter hour or part thereof taken after the first half hour.
