CHANGES IN LOCAL GOVERNMENT AREAS

The Woodspring (Parishes) Order 1982

Made - - - - - 16th March 1982

Coming into Operation—

for the purposes
described in article 2 24th March 1982

for all other purposes 1st April 1982

Whereas the District Council of Woodspring, under section 48(8) of the Local Government Act 1972(a), made recommendations to the Local Government Boundary Commission for England for proposals in relation to parishes in the district;

And whereas the said Commission, under sections 47 and 51(1) of the said Act, on 12th March 1981, made such proposals to the Secretary of State for the Environment:

Now therefore the Secretary of State for the Environment, in exercise of his powers under section 51(2) and 67(4) of the said Act and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following order:—

Title and commencement

1. This order may be cited as the Woodspring (Parishes) Order 1982.

2. 24th March 1982 is hereby specified as the day on which this order shall come into operation for any purposes set out in Regulation 4(1) (Coming into operation of order) of the Regulations.

For all other purposes this order shall come into operation on the appointed day.

Interpretation

3. In this order—

“the appointed day” means 1st April 1982;

“the boundary map” means the map printed for Her Majesty’s Stationery

Office by Ordnance Survey as "Boundary map referred to in the Woodspring (Parishes) Order 1982", the sheets of the map being respectively marked with the numbers 1 to 17;

"the county" means the County of Avon;

"the district" means the District of Woodspring; and

"the Regulations" means the Local Government Area Changes Regulations 1976(a) as amended by the Local Government Area Changes (Amendment) Regulations 1978(b).

Changes in areas

4.— (1) The parts of parishes described in column (1) of the Schedule to this order and marked on the boundary map as specified in column (2) shall, in so far as parishes, wards thereof, electoral divisions of the county and wards of the district are specified in respect thereof in columns (3) to (6), be transferred to or form part of such areas. The area marked A6 on sheets 6, 7, 12 and 13 of the boundary map shall form part of the Weston-super-Mare petty sessional division.

(2) The part of the Parish of Kewstoke marked B on sheet 11 of the boundary map shall cease to form part of any parish and shall form part of the Worle electoral division of the county and of the Weston-super-Mare North ward of the district.

(3) The part of the area of the former borough of Weston-super-Mare marked C on sheet 11 of the boundary map shall form part of the Parish of Kewstoke, of the Priory electoral division of the county and of the Banwell ward of the district.

Statutory definitions of areas

5. In any application of sub-paragraph (b) of paragraph (1) (certain definitions of areas) of regulation 40 of the Regulations, the area to which article 4(2) applies shall be deemed to have been added to the area of the former borough of Weston-super-Mare, and the area to which article 5(3) applies shall be deemed to have ceased to form part of such area.

Local Acts, orders and byelaws

6.— (1) The area of the former borough of Weston-super-Mare shall be a relevant area within the meaning of regulation 41 (Local Acts, orders and byelaws) of the Regulations and is hereby specified in relation to paragraph (4) of that regulation, and the area comprising—

the first mentioned area other than the part thereof to which article 4(3) applies; and

the area to which article 4(2) applies

is hereby specified in relation to the first mentioned area.

(2) The provision of paragraph (1) is without prejudice to the operation of regulation 41(3) of the Regulations in respect of any parish as altered.

- (b) adjustments between the Parish of Kewstoke and the part of the district which is not comprised in any parish.

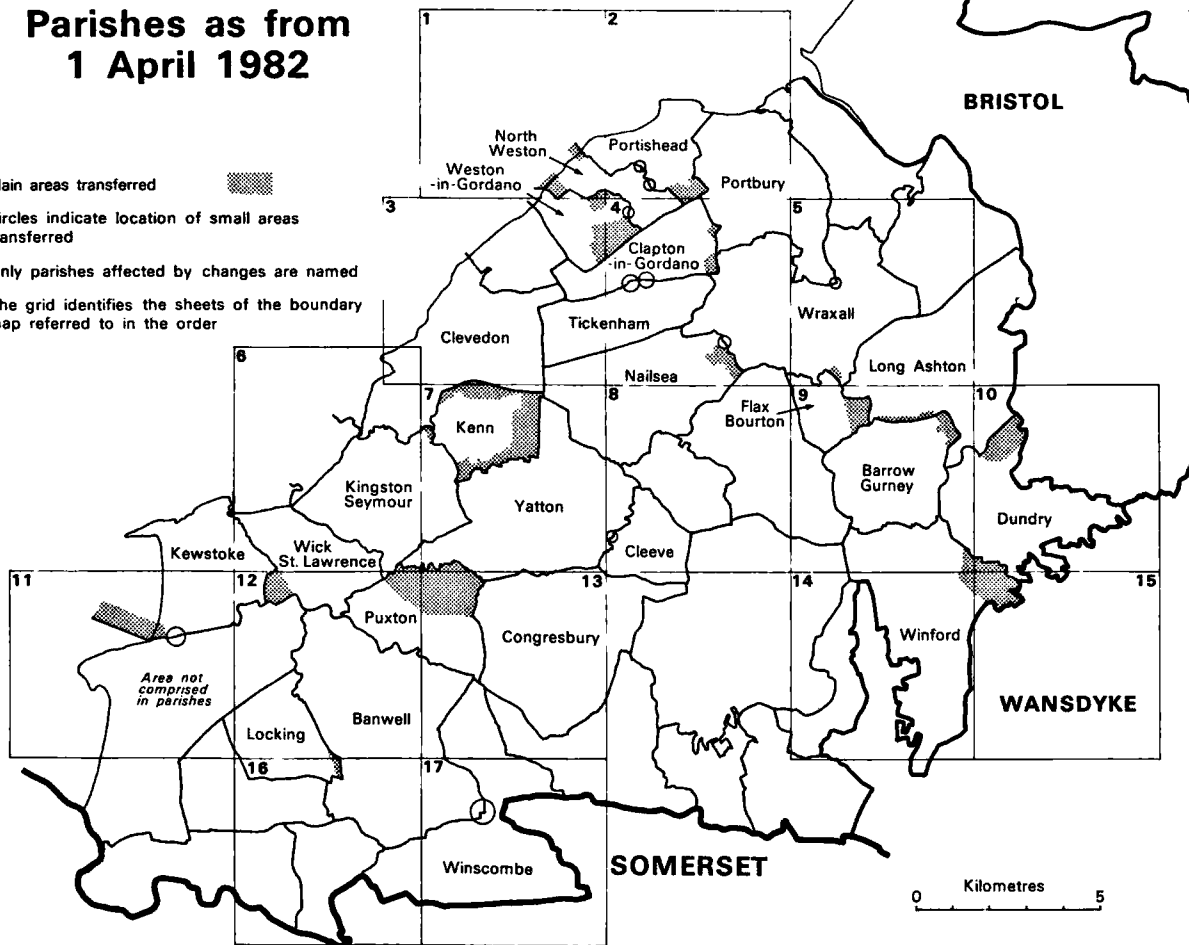
The map forming part of this note shows the areas. This map also incorporates a grid identifying the sheets of the boundary map referred to in article 3 of the order.
