## The London Traffic (40 mph Speed Limit) (No. 1) Regulations, 1958 (Variation) Order 1982

Coming into Operation

15th January 1982

The Secretary of State for Transport in exercise of his powers under Sections 74(1) and (2) and 84D of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1967(a), and now vested in him (b), and of all other enabling powers, hereby makes the following Order:—

- 1. This Order may be cited as The London Traffic (40 mph Speed Limit) (No. 1) Regulations, 1958 (Variation) Order 1982 and shall come into operation on 15th January 1982.
- 2. The London Traffic (40 mph Speed Limit) (No. 1) Regulations, 1958(c) shall be varied and have effect as though for the item numbered 8(i) in the Schedule to those Regulations there were substituted the words "In the Boroughs of Haringey and Enfield from a point 70 yards east of its junction with the eastern arm of Waltheof Gardens, Tottenham, to a point 240 yards north of its junction with Bullsmoor Lane, Enfield;".
