The Fishing Nets (Variation) Order 1982

The Minister of Agriculture, Fisheries and Food and the Secretaries of State respectively concerned with the sea fishing industry in Scotland, Wales and Northern Ireland, acting jointly, in exercise of the powers conferred on them by sections 3 and 20(1) of the Sea Fish (Conservation) Act 1967 (a), and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, hereby make the following order:—

Title and commencement

1. This order may be cited as the Fishing Nets (Variation) Order 1982, and shall come into operation on 30th March 1982.

Variation of principal order

2. The Fishing Nets Order 1981 (b) shall be varied by substituting—

- (a) the words “in any part of its cod-end” for the words “in any of its parts” in article 5(2) thereof;
- (b) “30th June 1982” for the date mentioned in article 14 thereof.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Order.)

This order extends until 30th June 1982 the duration of the Fishing Nets Order 1981. It also amends article 5(2) of the order, which relates to the exemption of small meshed nets used for certain fish, so that the exemption is disapplied only if the net has a mesh of over 50mm in any part of its cod-end.
