Diseases of Fish (Infected Area) (Scotland)
(No. 14) Order 1982

Made - - - - - 5th May 1982

Coming into operation 12th May 1982

The Secretary of State, being satisfied as respects the area hereinafter mentioned that certain waters therein are infected waters, in exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 2(1) as read with section 11 of the Diseases of Fish Act 1937(a), and all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order:—

Citation and commencement

1. This order may be cited as the Diseases of Fish (Infected Area) (Scotland) (No. 14) Order 1982 and shall come into operation on 12th May 1982.

Infected area

2. The area comprising the fish farm (cage units) situated on the north side of Lochearn, Perthshire and owned by Crawfords Ltd is hereby declared to be an infected area for the purposes of the Diseases of Fish Act 1937.

Control of movement of fish etc.

3. No person shall without the previous consent in writing of the Secretary of State move out of the area declared by Article 2 above to be an infected area any live fish or eggs of fish or foodstuff for fish.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This Order declares the fish farm situated on the north side of Lochearn in Perthshire and owned by Crawfords Ltd to be an infected area for the purposes of the Diseases of Fish Act 1937 and prohibits the movement out of the area of any live fish, eggs of fish or foodstuff for fish.
