## ROAD TRAFFIC

**The Motor Vehicles (Tests) (Amendment) Regulations 1982**

The Secretary of State for Transport, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 43(6) of the Road Traffic Act 1972 (a) and now vested in him (b) and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with representative organisations in accordance with the provisions of section 199(2) of the said Act, hereby makes the following Regulations:—

1. These Regulations shall come into operation on 1st July 1982 and may be cited as the Motor Vehicles (Tests) (Amendment) Regulations 1982.
2. The Motor Vehicles (Tests) Regulations 1981 (c) are hereby amended so that in Regulation 20 (Fees for examinations), in paragraph (1) —
  - (a) in sub-paragraph (a) for “£4.26” there is substituted “£4.50”; and
  - (b) in sub-paragraph (c) for “£7.10” there is substituted “£7.50”.

## EXPLANATORY NOTE

*(This Note is not part of the Regulations.)*

These Regulations amend the Motor Vehicles (Tests) Regulations 1981 so that:—

- (i) the fee for the examination of a motor bicycle (without a sidecar) is increased from £4.26 to £4.50; and
- (ii) the fee for examination of any other vehicle (not being a vehicle in Class VI) is increased from £7.10 to £7.50.

These increases take effect as to examinations conducted on or after 1st July 1982.
