

**1982 No. 915 (S. 120)****RATING AND VALUATION****The Assessor of Public Undertakings (Payment of Transfer Values) (Scotland) Regulations 1982**

In exercise of the powers conferred on me by section 5(7) of the Local Government (Scotland) Act 1975(a) and of all other powers enabling me in that behalf, I hereby make the following regulations:—

**1.**—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Assessor of Public Undertakings (Payment of Transfer Values) (Scotland) Regulations 1982 and shall come into operation on 31st July 1982.

(2) In these regulations “the principal Regulations” means the Assessor of Public Undertakings (Pensionable Employment) (Scotland) Regulations 1950(b).

**2.** Where the Secretary of State has paid to the Treasury a transfer value under Regulation 3 of the principal Regulations the Secretary of State shall recover the amount thereof from the bodies whose lands and heritages were valued by the Assessor in the year 1981–82 in the same manner as the remuneration or salary of the Assessor and his clerks and other officers as prescribed in section 29 of the Lands Valuation (Scotland) Act 1854(c).

**3.** Regulation 4 of the principal Regulations is hereby revoked.

## EXPLANATORY NOTE

*(This Note is not part of the Regulations.)*

These Regulations provide for the recovery by the Secretary of State of any transfer values that he pays to the Treasury under Regulation 3 of the principal Regulations following the entry of the Assessor of Public Undertakings (Scotland), or any clerk or other officer employed by him, into the Civil Service. The payments are to be recovered from those bodies whose lands and heritages were valued by the Assessor in the year 1981-82. Regulation 4 of the principal Regulations is revoked.
