NURSES, MIDWIVES AND HEALTH VISITORS

**The Nurses, Midwives and Health Visitors Act 1979
(Membership of Central Council) Order 1982**

Made - - - 13th July 1982

Laid before Parliament 21st July 1982

Coming into Operation 1st November 1983

In exercise of the powers conferred upon me by section 1(2) of, and paragraphs 1(1) and 2(1) and (2) of Schedule 1 to, the Nurses, Midwives and Health Visitors Act 1979(a) I hereby make the following order:—

Citation and commencement

1. This order may be cited as the Nurses, Midwives and Health Visitors Act 1979 (Membership of Central Council) Order 1982 and shall come into operation on 1st November 1983.

Termination of initial membership of Central Council

2. The day appointed for the purposes of paragraph 2(1) of Schedule 1 to the Nurses, Midwives and Health Visitors Act 1979 (termination of initial membership of Central Council) shall be 1st November 1983.

Membership of Central Council

3. The Central Council shall consist of forty-five members being—

- (a) seven members nominated by each of the National Boards, and
- (b) seventeen members appointed by the Secretary of State.

Term of office of members

4. Members of the Central Council shall hold office for a period of five years.

Revocation

5. The Nurses, Midwives and Health Visitors Act 1979 (Membership of Central Council) Order 1980(b) is hereby revoked.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Order.)

This Order appoints 1st November 1983 as the day on which the initial membership of the United Kingdom Central Council for Nursing, Midwifery and Health Visiting is terminated and revokes the order which specified the initial number of members of the Council. In addition this order specifies the number of members of the Council after the day appointed by the order and their terms of office.
