**Petroleum Stocks (Amendment) Order 1982**

The Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 6(6)(b) of the Energy Act 1976 and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby orders as follows:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Petroleum Stocks (Amendment) Order 1982 and shall come into operation on 15th August 1982.
2. Article 4 of the Petroleum Stocks Order 1976(1) shall cease to have effect.
