The Public Health (Infectious Diseases) (Scotland) Amendment Regulations 1983

In exercise of the powers conferred on me by section 1 of the Public Health (Scotland) Act 1945(a), and of all other powers enabling me in that behalf, I hereby make the following regulations:—

- 1. These regulations may be cited as the Public Health (Infectious Diseases) (Scotland) Amendment Regulations 1983 and shall come into operation on the 15th August 1983.
- 2. Regulation 6 (fees for notification) of the Public Health (Infectious Diseases) (Scotland) Regulations 1975(b) is hereby revoked.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Regulations.)

These Regulations revoke regulation 6 of the Public Health (Infectious Diseases) (Scotland) Regulations 1975 which specifies the fee payable to medical practitioners for providing certificates reporting cases of notifiable infectious diseases.

This revocation is consequential upon the terms of section 71A of the Health Services and Public Health Act 1968 (c. 46), as inserted by section 26(2) of the Health and Social Services and Social Security Adjudications Act 1983 (c. 41), which empowers the Secretary of State to specify such fees in a direction.
