In exercise of the powers conferred upon me by section 29 of the Licensing Act 1964(a) as extended by section 4 of the Licensing (Occasional Permissions) Act 1983(b), I hereby make the following Order:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Licensing (Fees) Order 1983 and shall come into operation on 9th August 1983.

2. The fee which may be charged on the grant of an occasional permission under section 1 of the Licensing (Occasional Permissions) Act 1983 shall be £4.00:

Provided that no more than £4.00 shall be charged in respect of more than one permission granted on one day to a single applicant.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Order.)

This Order prescribes a fee of £4 to be charged by clerks to licensing justices on the grant of an occasional permission. Where more than one permission is granted on the same day to one applicant, the fee is still £4.
