

1983 No. 1042**AGRICULTURE****The Common Agricultural Policy (Wine) (Amendment)
Regulations 1983**

The Minister of Agriculture, Fisheries and Food and the Secretary of State, being Ministers designated **(a)** for the purposes of section 2(2) of the European Communities Act 1972 **(b)** in relation to the common agricultural policy of the European Economic Community, acting jointly in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by the said section 2(2), and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, hereby make the following regulations:—

Title, commencement and interpretation

1.—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Common Agricultural Policy (Wine) (Amendment) Regulations 1983 and shall come into operation on the 17th August 1983.

(2) In these regulations “the principal regulations” means the Common Agricultural Policy (Wine) Regulations 1982 **(c)**.

Amendment of definition of “local authority” as respects Scotland

2. Regulation 3 of the principal regulations shall be amended by deleting paragraph (6)(a)(ii) and substituting therefor a new paragraph (6)(a)(ii) as follows:—

“(ii) as respects Scotland, an islands or district council which is the enforcement authority for the purposes of the Food and Drugs (Scotland) Act 1956;” **(d)**.

Amendments to the Schedules to the principal regulations

3.—(1) Schedule 1 to the principal regulations (which lists regulations of the European Communities concerned with the production and marketing of wine and related products, for the purpose of which local authorities, the Minister, the Commissioners and the Wine Standards Board are designated competent authorities or agencies in the United Kingdom) shall be amended by adding—

- (a) at the end of the first column of item 8 “, and by Commission Regulation (EEC) No: 131/83 (O.J. No: L17, p. 14) (1983 Vol. 26)”;
- (b) at the end of the first column of item 12 “, and by Council Regulation (EEC) No: 2144/82 (O.J. No: L227, p.1) (1982 Vol. 25), and by Council Regulation (EEC) No: 3082/82 (O.J. No: L326, p.1) (1982 Vol. 25)”;
- (c) at the end of the first column of item 13 “, and by Council Regulation (EEC) No: 2145/82 (O.J. No: L227, p.10) (1982 Vol. 25)”;
- (d) at the end of the first column of item 14 “, and by Council Regulation (EEC) No: 3267/82 (O.J. No: L347, p.1) (1982 Vol. 25)”.
- (e) at the end of the first column of item 25 “, and by Commission Regulation (EEC) No: 1224/83 (O.J. No: L134, p.1) (1983 Vol. 26)”.

(2) Schedule 2 to the principal regulations (which lists regulations of the European Communities concerned as aforesaid which are to be enforced in the United Kingdom by local authorities, the Minister, the Commissioners or the Wine Standards Board) shall be amended by adding at the end of Column 2 of item 1 in Part III “and by regulation 1224/83: Article 1”.

(3) Schedule 2 to the principal regulations shall be amended by adding in Part V thereof—

- (a) at the end of Column 1 of item 7 “as amended by regulation 2144/82: Article 1(8)”;
- (b) at the end of Column 2 of item 8 “and regulation 3267/82: Article 1”;
- (c) at the end of Column 1 of item 12 “and by regulation 2144/82: Article 1(13)”;
- (d) at the end of Column 1 of item 17 “and by regulation 2144/82: Article 1(14)”.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Regulations.)

These regulations amend the Common Agricultural Policy (Wine) Regulations 1982 (“the principal regulations”) by—

(1) revising the definition of “local authority” so that, as respects Scotland, islands or district councils, rather than regional or islands councils, are the enforcement authorities. This revision is consequent upon the amendment of the definition of “local authority” in section 26 of the Food and Drugs (Scotland) Act 1956 by section 22 of the Local Government and Planning (Scotland) Act 1982 (c. 43); and

(2) adding to the Schedules details of relevant regulations of the European Communities which have been adopted since the principal regulations came into operation.
