(Amendment No. 2) Regulations 1983**

The Secretary of State, in exercise of powers conferred on him by section 5(2) of the Merchant Shipping (Mercantile Marine Fund) Act 1898(a) and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following Regulations:—

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Merchant Shipping (Light Dues) (Amendment No. 2) Regulations 1983 and shall come into operation on 22nd August 1983.

2. Part I of the Schedule to the Merchant Shipping (Light Dues) Regulations 1981(b) shall be further amended as follows:—

in the last line of paragraph 3 of the Scale of Payments, “10 tons” shall be substituted for “20 tons”.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Regulations.)

This Order corrects an error in the Merchant Shipping (Light Dues) (Amendment) Regulations 1983 (which came into operation on 1st June 1983) by altering the rate of light dues payable by visiting cruise ships from 72p per 20 tons per voyage to 72p per 10 tons per voyage. (Under the Merchant Shipping (Light Dues) Regulations 1981 the rate was 80p per 10 tons per voyage.)
