**The National Health Service (Constitution of District Health
 Authorities) (Transitory Provision) Regulations 1983**

<i>Made - - - -</i>	22nd July 1983
<i>Laid before Parliament</i>	25th July 1983
<i>Coming into Operation</i>	15th August 1983

The Secretary of State for Social Services, as respects England, and the Secretary of State for Wales, as respects Wales, in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by paragraph 12 of Schedule 5 to the National Health Service Act 1977(a) and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, hereby make the following regulations:—

Citation and commencement

1. These regulations may be cited as the National Health Service (Constitution of District Health Authorities) (Transitory Provision) Regulations 1983 and shall come into operation on 15th August 1983.

Transitory provision

2. An appointment of a member of an Authority, pursuant to the amendment effected by Article 2(3)(e) or, as the case may be, (4)(b) of the National Health Service (Constitution of District Health Authorities) Amendment (No. 2) Order 1983(b) (amendments made to principal Order in consequence of the repeal by the Health and Social Services and Social Security Adjudications Act 1983(c) of provisions relating to the designation of teaching authorities), shall not be made until a member of that Authority appointed, before the coming into operation of that Order, pursuant to Article 5(5) of the National Health Service (Constitution of District Health Authorities) Order 1981(d), ceases to be a member of that Authority.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Regulations.)

These regulations are made in consequence of amendments made by the National Health Service (Constitution of District Health Authorities) Amendment (No. 2) Order 1983 to the National Health Service (Constitution of District Health Authorities) Order 1981 whereby the number of members of district health authorities, the name of which formerly included the designation "teaching", appointed by Regional Health Authorities is increased by the same number as that of the additional members appointed to such Authorities. The regulations make transitory provision so that an appointment is not to be so made by a Regional Health Authority unless a vacancy arises amongst those additional members.
