ROAD TRAFFIC

The Motor Vehicles (Tests) (Amendment) Regulations 1983

Made - - - - - 25th July 1983
Laid before Parliament 10th August 1983
Coming into Operation 1st September 1983

The Secretary of State for Transport, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 43(2) and (6) of the Road Traffic Act 1972(a) and now vested in him(b), and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with representative organisations in accordance with the provisions of section 199(2) of that Act, hereby makes the following Regulations:—

1. These Regulations shall come into operation on 1st September 1983, and may be cited as the Motor Vehicles (Tests) (Amendment) Regulations 1983.

2. The Motor Vehicles (Tests) Regulations 1981(c) are hereby amended so that in the Regulations specified in column 1 of the Table below for the words specified in column 2 of that Table there are substituted the words specified in column 3 of that Table.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Regulations.)

These Regulations amend the Motor Vehicles (Tests) Regulations 1981 so that:—

- (i) the fee for the examination of a motor bicycle (without a sidecar) is increased from £4.50 to £5.40;
- (ii) the fee for examination of any other vehicle (not being a vehicle in Class VI) is increased from £7.50 to £9.00; and
- (iii) the fee for the supply of 100 forms of test certificate is increased from £18 to £20.
