## SAVINGS BANKS

**The Trustee Savings Banks (Fund for the Banks for Savings)  
 (Amendment) (No. 2) Order 1983**

<i>Made</i>	- - -	25th October 1983
<i>Laid before Parliament</i>		28th October 1983
<i>Coming into Operation</i>		21st November 1983

The Treasury, in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by paragraph 14(1) of Schedule 5 to the Trustee Savings Banks Act 1981(a) and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, hereby make the following Order:—

*Title and commencement*

1. This Order may be cited as the Trustee Savings Banks (Fund for the Banks for Savings) (Amendment) (No. 2) Order 1983 and shall come into operation on 21st November 1983.

*Interpretation*

2. In this Order “the Principal Order” means the Trustee Savings Banks (Fund for the Banks for Savings) (No. 2) Order 1979(b).

*Amendments to the Principal Order*

3. Schedule 2 to the Principal Order (individual limits, excluding interest, on the amounts which may be withdrawn by trustee savings banks from the Fund for the Banks for Savings in the specified periods of six months) shall be amended —

- (a) by the deletion in column (1) of the references to the trustee savings banks which are specified in the Schedule hereto and the deletion of the entries for each of them in column (2) in so far as those entries relate to the period of six months ending on 20th May 1984 and to each of the periods of six months thereafter; and
- (b) by the insertion at the beginning of column (1) of “England and Wales” and the insertions of “£84,327,000” as the entries for it in column (2) in so far as those entries relate to the period of six months ending on 20th May 1984 and to each of the periods of six months thereafter.

## EXPLANATORY NOTE

*(This Note is not part of the Order.)*

This Order amends the Trustee Savings Banks (Fund for the Banks for Savings) (No. 2) Order 1979 ("the 1979 Order") which specifies in column (2) of Schedule 2 the limit on the amounts which may be withdrawn with accrued interest during each period of six months ending on 20th May and 20th November each year until 20th May 1986 by the trustee savings banks listed in column (1) of that Schedule.

Since the making of the 1979 Order, the four Scottish trustee savings banks originally listed have amalgamated and formed the Trustee Savings Bank Scotland and appropriate amendments to Schedule 2 were made by S.I. 1983/636. Two amalgamations involving English trustee savings banks have also taken place and in consequence Schedule 2 was amended by S.I. 1981/319. The trustee savings banks in England and Wales will amalgamate on 21st November 1983 and form the Trustee Savings Bank England and Wales. This Order makes provision for this by deleting from the 1979 Order, as amended, the entries in columns (1) and (2) relating to the ten relevant trustee savings banks, inserting a reference to the Trustee Savings Bank England and Wales in column (1) and imposing a limit on the amount which may be withdrawn by it, with accrued interest, in each of the remaining six monthly periods in column (2). The amount specified for each of the six months is £84,327,000.
