The Lord Chancellor, in exercise of the power conferred on him by section 130 of the Supreme Court Act 1981(a), and with the concurrence of the Lord Chief Justice, the Master of the Rolls, the President of the Family Division, the Vice-Chancellor and the Treasury, hereby makes the following Order:—

1.—(1) This Order may be cited as the Supreme Court Fees (Amendment) Order 1983 and shall come into operation on 12th December 1983.

(2) In this Order a fee referred to by number means the fee so numbered in the Schedule to the Supreme Court Fees Order 1980(b).

2. In Fee No. 1, for the figure “50.00” in column 2 there shall be substituted the figure “55.00”.

3. In Fee No. 14, for the figure “5.00” in column 2, there shall be substituted the figure “6.00”.
