The Local Review Committee (Scotland) Amendment Rules 1983

In exercise of the powers conferred on me by section 59(6) of the Criminal Justice Act 1967 (a) and of all other powers enabling me in that behalf, I hereby make the following Rules:—

1. These Rules may be cited as the Local Review Committee (Scotland) Amendment Rules 1983 and shall come into operation on 15th December 1983.

2. The Local Review Committee (Scotland) Rules 1967 (b) shall be amended as follows:—

- (a) Rule 8(4) thereof shall be deleted;
- (b) “Castle Huntly young offenders institution” and “Noranside young offenders institution” shall be added to the Schedule thereto; and
- (c) “Edinburgh young offenders institution” shall be deleted from the said Schedule.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Rules.)

These Rules amend the Local Review Committee (Scotland) Rules 1967 by adding to the Schedule specifying the prisons and young offenders institutions at which local review committees are to be established entries in respect of Castle Huntly young offenders institution and Noranside young offenders institution, and by deleting the existing entry in respect of Edinburgh young offenders institution as that institution no longer exists. They also delete Rule 8(4) of the 1967 Rules which provided that a local review committee is not obliged to review the case of a prisoner under Rule 8 while any criminal or disciplinary proceedings against the prisoner are pending or the prisoner is undergoing certain punishments for disciplinary offences or a period in a segregation unit.
