**The Local Acts (Welfare Services) (Consequential Repeals) Order
1983**

The Secretary of State for Social Services, in exercise of the powers conferred upon him by section 31(1)(a) of the Health and Social Services and Social Security Adjudications Act 1983 (a) and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, after consultation with such local authorities as he considers to be affected, hereby makes the following Order:—

Citation, commencement and interpretation

1.—(1) This Order may be cited as the Local Acts (Welfare Services) (Consequential Repeals) Order 1983.

(2) Articles 1 and 3 of, and the Schedule to, this Order shall come into operation on 1st January 1984.

(3) Article 2 of this Order shall come into operation on the date on which section 11(1) of, and Part I of Schedule 4 to, the Act (residential care homes) come into force.

(4) In this Order the “Act” means the Health and Social Services and Social Security Adjudications Act 1983.

Repeal of local Acts consequential on section 11(1) of, and Part I of Schedule 4 to, the Act

2. The provisions of section 81 of the Hertfordshire County Council Act 1960 (b) and section 75 of the Devon County Council Act 1961 (c) which are inconsistent with or have become unnecessary in consequence of section 11(1) of, and Part I of Schedule 4 to, the Act are hereby repealed.

Repeal of local Acts consequential on section 17 of the Act

3. The provisions of the local Acts specified in column (2) of the Schedule to this Order which are inconsistent with or have become unnecessary in consequence of section 17 of the Act (charges for local authority services in England and Wales) are hereby repealed.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Order.)

This Order repeals with effect from 1st January 1984 provisions of local Acts which were passed before, and are inconsistent with, or have become unnecessary in consequence of, section 17 of the Health and Social Services and Social Security Adjudications Act 1983. Section 17 makes provision with respect to charges for local authority services and replaces the charging provision for welfare services contained in the local Acts specified in the Schedule to this Order.

The Order also repeals from the date on which section 11(1) of, and Part I of Schedule 4, to the Act (registration of residential care homes) come into force the provisions contained in the Hertfordshire County Council Act 1960 and the Devon County Council Act 1961 relating to the registration of homes for disabled persons and old persons.
