PROFESSIONS SUPPLEMENTARY TO MEDICINE**The Professions Supplementary to Medicine (Registration Rules)
(Amendment) Order of Council 1983***Made - - - - 6th December 1983*

At the Council Chamber, Whitehall, the 6th day of December 1983

By the Lords of Her Majesty's Most Honourable Privy Council

Whereas in pursuance of section 2 of the Professions Supplementary to Medicine Act 1960 (a) the Council for Professions Supplementary to Medicine has made the Registration (Amendment) Rules 1983:

And whereas by subsection (3) of the said section such rules shall not come into force until confirmed by Order of the Privy Council:

Now, therefore, Their Lordships, having taken the said rules into consideration, are hereby pleased to confirm the same as set out in the Schedule to this Order.

This Order may be cited as the Professions Supplementary to Medicine (Registration Rules) (Amendment) Order of Council 1983.

SCHEDULE**THE REGISTRATION (AMENDMENT) RULES 1983**

The Council for Professions Supplementary to Medicine, in exercise of its powers under section 2 of the Professions Supplementary to Medicine Act 1960 hereby makes the following rules:—

1. These rules may be cited as the Registration (Amendment) Rules 1983.
2. The Registration Rules 1962, as scheduled to the Professions Supplementary to Medicine (Registration Rules) Order of Council 1962 (b) shall be further amended as follows:—

(a) In Rule 2 should be added:—

“ ‘Council’ means Council for Professions Supplementary to Medicine to which all payments of fees are due in accordance with section 18(1) of the First Schedule to the Act.”

“ ‘Direct debit’ means a mandate in the form from time to time prescribed by the Council and its bankers as governed by the London Clearing Banks’ and Scottish Clearing Banks’ Direct Debiting Scheme 1967 or under any variation thereof subsequently made.”

(b) S.I. 1962/1765, to which there are amendments not relevant to these rules.

(b) Delete Rule 7 and substitute the following:

“7(a) Except where any registrant elects to make payment for the renewal annually of registration by a direct debit method, not later than the date in each year set out in column 1 of the Schedule hereto the Board for the profession set out in column 2 of the Schedule shall cause the Registrar to send to the registered permanent address of every member of that profession whose registration will expire on the date in the same year set out in column 3 of the Schedule the appropriate form of application for the retention of a name in a Register, together in each case with a notice of the fees payable, and a warning that non-payment will entail removal from the Register, but failure by a registered person to receive a form or notice shall not constitute a ground for retention or restoration of a name.

- (b) (i) Subject to the provisions of (a) above a registrant may elect to pay registration fees by direct debit.
- (ii) Whenever any sum payable under a direct debit is to be varied the Registrar shall, not less than 35 days before such payment is due, send to every registrant who has elected to make payment by direct debit mandate at his address for the time being entered in the register a notice specifying the amount to be paid under the direct debit and shall indicate the registrant's right to withdraw any mandate previously given. Such notice shall further indicate that the failure to make payment under the terms of the mandate previously given or by other means will lead to the removal from the register of the registrant's name.
- (iii) Failure by a registered person to receive a notice sent under the provisions of (b)(ii) herein shall not constitute a ground for retention or restoration of a name.”
