The Maidstone and Swale (Areas) Order 1983

Made	22nd December 1983
Laid before Parliament	10th January 1984
Coming into Operation—	
for the purposes described in article 2(1) -	1st February 1984
for all other purposes -	1st April 1984

Whereas the Local Government Boundary Commission for England, pursuant to sections 47 and 51(1) of the Local Government Act 1972(a), on 25th March 1982, has made proposals to the Secretary of State for the Environment for the transfer of part of the borough of Maidstone to the borough of Swale and part of the borough of Swale to the borough of Maidstone:

And whereas the Secretary of State has decided to give effect to those proposals without modification:

Now, therefore, the Secretary of State for the Environment, in exercise of his powers under sections 51(2) and 67(4) of the said Act and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following order:—

Title and commencement

- 1. This order may be cited as the Maidstone and Swale (Areas) Order 1983.
- 2. (1) 1st February 1984 is hereby specified as the day on which this order shall come into operation for any purpose set out in regulation 4(1) (coming into operation of order) of the Local Government Area Changes Regulations 1976(b).
- (2) For all other purposes this order shall come into operation on 1st April 1984.

Changes in areas

- 3. (1) That part of the borough of Swale shown coloured yellow and marked A1 on the map issued by the Department of the Environment entitled "Map of the Maidstone and Swale (Areas) Order 1983" shall—
 - (a) be transferred to the borough of Maidstone;
 - (b) form part of the Maidstone Rural North electoral division of the county of Kent and of the Detling ward of the borough of Maidstone; and
 - (c) form part of the parish of Stockbury, of the Maidstone petty sessional division, and of the Maidstone coroner's district.
- (2) That part of the borough of Maidstone shown coloured yellow and marked A2 on the map referred to in (1) shall—
 - (a) be transferred to the borough of Swale;
 - (b) form part of the Swale West electoral division of the county of Kent and of the Borden ward of the borough of Swale; and
 - (c) form part of the parish of Borden, of the Sittingbourne petty sessional division and of the North Kent coroner's district.

Town and country planning

4. The provisions applicable to any area transferred by article 3 of any local plan which has been adopted by the council of the borough from which the area is transferred shall have effect as if they were a local plan adopted by the council of the borough to which the area is transferred.

EXPLANATORY NOTE


