The Legal Aid in Criminal Proceedings (Costs) (Amendment) Regulations 1983

Made - - - 22nd February 1983

Laid before Parliament 11th March 1983

Coming into Operation 1st April 1983

The Lord Chancellor, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 39 of the Legal Aid Act 1974(a) and now vested in him(b) and all other powers enabling him in that behalf and having had regard to the principle of allowing fair remuneration according to the work actually and reasonably done, hereby makes the following Regulations:

- 1. These Regulations may be cited as the Legal Aid in Criminal Proceedings (Costs) (Amendment) Regulations 1983 and shall come into operation on 1st April 1983.
- 2. In these Regulations a regulation or schedule referred to by number means a regulation or schedule so numbered in the Legal Aid in Criminal Proceedings (Costs) Regulations 1982(c).
- 3.—(1) In regulation 5(3) for the date "30th June 1983" there shall be substituted "30th June 1984".
- (2) In regulation 8(2)(a) for the date "30th June 1983" there shall be substituted "30th June 1984".
- (3) For paragraph 1 of Schedule 1 there shall be substituted, in respect of work done on or after 1st April 1983, the following paragraph:
 - "1. Subject to paragraphs 2 and 3, the appropriate authority shall allow fees for work allowed by it under regulation 5 at the following standard rates:

These Regulations amend the Legal Aid in Criminal Proceedings (Costs) Regulations 1982 and increase the rates of remuneration for legal aid work in criminal proceedings done on or after 1st April 1983. The rates provided in the 1982 Regulations are increased overall by slightly below 5%.
