The Housing (Standard Amenities Approved Expense) (Scotland) Order 1983

In exercise of the powers conferred on me by section 7(5) and 48 of the Housing (Scotland) Act 1974(a) and of all other powers enabling me in that behalf, I hereby make the following order:—

Citation and commencement

1. This order may be cited as the Housing (Standard Amenities Approved Expense) (Scotland) Order 1983 and shall come into operation on 28th April 1983.

Revocation

2. The Housing (Standard Amenities Approved Expense) (Scotland) Order 1981(b) is hereby revoked.

Amounts of Approved Expense

3. Schedule I to the said Act of 1974 is hereby varied by substituting for Part I thereof the following:—

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Order.)

Section 7 of the Housing (Scotland) Act 1974 provides that local authorities have a duty to make house improvement grants which relate exclusively to the provision of standard amenities. Grants are made as a percentage of approved expense and maximum eligible amounts of approved expense are provided in Schedule I to the Act.

This Order increases the maximum eligible amounts specified in Part I of Schedule I to the Act in relation to the standard amenities described therein.
