## ANIMALS

**The Slaughter of Animals (Revision of Penalties) (Scotland) Regulations 1983**

<i>Made - - - -</i>	17th June 1983
<i>Laid before Parliament</i>	30th June 1983
<i>Coming into Operation</i>	21st July 1983

In exercise of the powers conferred on me by section 9 as read with section 18 of the Slaughter of Animals (Scotland) Act 1980 (a), and of all other powers enabling me in that behalf, I hereby make the following regulations:—

*Citation and commencement*

1. These regulations may be cited as the Slaughter of Animals (Revision of Penalties) (Scotland) Regulations 1983 and shall come into operation on 21st July 1983.

*Revision of penalties*

2.—(1) In regulation 25(2) of the Slaughter of Animals (Prevention of Cruelty) (Scotland) Regulations 1955 (b) for “£100” there shall be substituted “£200”.

(2) In regulation 5(2) of the Slaughter of Animals (Stunning Pens) (Scotland) Regulations 1963 (c) for “£100” there shall be substituted “£200”.

## EXPLANATORY NOTE

*(This Note is not part of the Regulations.)*

In consequence of the Criminal Justice Act 1982 (c.48) these regulations amend the Slaughter of Animals (Prevention of Cruelty) (Scotland) Regulations 1955 and the Slaughter of Animals (Stunning Pens) (Scotland) Regulations 1963 by increasing the maximum fine to which a person guilty of an offence against those regulations is liable, from £100 to £200.
