The Merchant Shipping Act 1965 (Isle of Man) Order 1984

The Queen's Most Excellent Majesty in Council

Her Majesty, in pursuance of section 6 of the Merchant Shipping Act 1965(a) and section 738(1) of the Merchant Shipping Act 1894(b), is pleased, by and with the advice of Her Privy Council, to order, and it is hereby ordered, as follows:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Merchant Shipping Act 1965 (Isle of Man) Order 1984 and shall come into operation on 31st August 1984.
2. It is hereby directed that sections 1, 3, 7(1) and 8 of, and the entries relating to the Merchant Shipping Act 1894 in Schedule 1 to, the Merchant Shipping Act 1965(c) shall extend to the Isle of Man with the exceptions, adaptations and modifications specified in the Schedule to this Order.
3. The Merchant Shipping Act 1965 (Isle of Man) Order 1969(d) is hereby revoked.

SCHEDULE

EXCEPTIONS, ADAPTATIONS AND MODIFICATIONS TO THE PROVISIONS OF
THE MERCHANT SHIPPING ACT 1965 AS EXTENDED TO THE ISLE OF MAN

1. Any reference to an enactment shall be construed, unless the contrary intention appears, as a reference to it as it has effect in the Isle of Man.
2. Without prejudice to any provision of the Interpretation Act 1978, in so far as any regulations made under any provision of the Merchant Shipping Act 1965 as extended by the Merchant Shipping Act 1965 (Isle of Man) Order 1969 could have been made under that provision as extended by this Order, they shall have effect as if so made.
3. In section 1(1)—
 - (a) for “the Board of Trade by statutory instrument” there shall be substituted “the Isle of Man Harbour Board with the approval of Tynwald”; and
 - (b) for “the commencement of this Act” there shall be substituted “the extension of this Act to the Isle of Man by the Merchant Shipping Act 1965 (Isle of Man) Order 1984”.
4. In section 1(4), for all the words after “in that behalf by” there shall be substituted “the Isle of Man Harbour Board”.
5. In section 1(6)—
 - (a) for “the Board of Trade” (in both places) there shall be substituted “the Isle of Man Harbour Board”; and
 - (b) for “the United Kingdom” there shall be substituted “the Isle of Man”.
6. Section 1(7) shall be omitted.
7. In section 3, for “the Merchant Shipping (Fishing Boats Registry) Order 1927” there shall be substituted “the Merchant Shipping (Fishing Boats Registry) Order 1981”.
8. Section 8(4) shall be omitted.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Order.)

This Order extends to the Isle of Man the Merchant Shipping Act 1965, with the exceptions, adaptations and modifications specified in the Schedule to the Order. It revokes and replaces the Merchant Shipping Act 1965 (Isle of Man) Order 1969; its effect is to extend to the Isle of Man amendments to the 1965 Act made subsequent to the 1969 Order.
