**The Merchant Shipping Load Line Convention (Isle of Man)
(Revocation) Order 1984**

Her Majesty, in pursuance of section 738(1) of the Merchant Shipping Act 1894(a), is pleased, by and with the advice of Her Privy Council, to order, and it is hereby ordered, as follows:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Merchant Shipping Load Line Convention (Isle of Man) (Revocation) Order 1984 and shall come into operation on 31st August 1984.

2. The Merchant Shipping Load Line Convention (Isle of Man) Order 1935(b) is hereby revoked.

 EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Order.)

This Order revokes the Merchant Shipping Load Line Convention (Isle of Man) Order 1935, which extended to the Isle of Man certain provisions of the Merchant Shipping (Safety and Load Line Conventions) Act 1932. The revocation is consequent upon the enactment of the Merchant Shipping (Load Lines) Act 1981 (an Act of Tynwald).
