The County of Leicestershire (Electoral Arrangements) Order 1984

Made - - - 4th February 1984

Coming into operation in accordance with Article 2

Whereas in pursuance of section 51(1) of the Local Government Act 1972(a) the Local Government Boundary Commission for England on 11th March 1983 submitted proposals for the future electoral arrangements for the County of Leicestershire:

Now, therefore, in exercise of the power conferred upon me by sections 51(2) and 67 of the said Act, I hereby make the following Order:—

- 1. This Order may be cited as the County of Leicestershire (Electoral Arrangements) Order 1984.
- 2. This Order shall come into operation on 2nd May 1985 except that for the purpose of all proceedings preliminary or relating to an election to be held on or after that day this Order shall come into operation on 10th October 1984.
- 3.—(1) The existing electoral divisions of the County of Leicestershire shall be abolished and that county shall be divided into eighty-five electoral divisions which shall bear the names set out in column 1 of the Schedule to this Order, and each such electoral division shall comprise the existing areas specified opposite thereto in column 2 of that Schedule.
- (2) The number of councillors to be elected for each electoral division constituted by this Order shall be one.
- 4. Where a boundary is described in the Schedule to this Order as running along a road, railway line, footway, waterway or other similar geographical feature, it shall be treated as running along the centre line thereof.
- 5. The ordinary elections of all councillors for the County of Leicestershire shall be held simultaneously on the ordinary day of election of county councillors in 1985 and every fourth year thereafter.
