**The Slaughter of Pigs (Anaesthesia) (Amendment) Regulations
1984**

<i>Made - - - -</i>	15th August 1984
<i>Laid before Parliament</i>	24th August 1984
<i>Coming into Operation</i>	17th September 1984

The Minister of Agriculture, Fisheries and Food in relation to England and the Secretary of State in relation to Wales, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 38 of the Slaughterhouses Act 1974(a) and now vested in them(b), and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, after consultation with such organisations as appear to them to represent the interests concerned in accordance with subsection (1) of the said section 38, hereby make the following regulations—

Title and commencement

1. These regulations may be cited as the Slaughter of Pigs (Anaesthesia) (Amendment) Regulations 1984 and shall come into operation on 17th September 1984.

Amendment

2. In regulation 14 of the Slaughter of Pigs (Anaesthesia) Regulations 1958(c) for the words “two hundred pounds” there shall be substituted the words “four hundred pounds”.

Revocation

3. The Slaughter of Pigs (Anaesthesia) (Amendment) Regulations 1983(d) are hereby revoked.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Regulations.)

These regulations amend the Slaughter of Pigs (Anaesthesia) Regulations 1958 by increasing (in Regulation 2) the maximum fine to which any person guilty of an offence against those Regulations is liable from £200 to £400.
