The Police (Scotland) Amendment Regulations 1984

In exercise of the powers conferred on me by section 26 of the Police (Scotland) Act 1967(a), and of all other powers enabling me in that behalf, and after taking into consideration the recommendations made by the Police Negotiating Board for the United Kingdom and furnishing the said Board with a draft of the regulations in accordance with section 2(1) of the Police Negotiating Board Act 1980(b), I hereby make the following regulations:—

Citation

1. These regulations may be cited as the Police (Scotland) Amendment Regulations 1984.

Interpretation

2. In these regulations any reference to the principal regulations is a reference to the Police (Scotland) Regulations 1976(c).

Operation and effect

3. These regulations shall come into operation on 1st November 1984 and shall have effect, for the purposes of regulations 5, 6 and 7 thereof, as from 1st September 1984.

Amendments

4. In the Table in paragraph 1 of Schedule 2 to the principal regulations (annual leave) there shall be substituted, in the entries relating to the rank of superintendent, for the words “30 days”, in each place where they occur, the words “31 days”.

5. In Schedule 3 to the principal regulations (Scales of pay) for Tables A and B there shall be substituted, respectively, Tables A and B set out in the Schedule to these regulations.

6. In paragraph (1) of Schedule 10 to the principal regulations (Dog handler's allowance), for the sums "£468" and "£633" there shall be substituted respectively the sums "£492" and "£666".

Revocations

7. Regulations 5 and 6 of the Police (Scotland) Amendment (No. 2) Regulations 1983(a) (relating respectively to scales of pay and to dog handler's allowance) are hereby revoked.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Regulations.)

These Regulations further amend the Police (Scotland) Regulations 1976 (“the principal regulations”). They come into operation on 1st November 1984 but have effect for the purposes of regulations 5, 6 and 7 as from 1st September 1984 (retrospection is authorised by section 26(3) of the Police (Scotland) Act 1967).

Regulation 4 increases the annual leave entitlement of superintendents from 30 to 31 days with effect from the current leave year.

Regulation 5 increases the rates of pay for police constables up to and including the rank of chief inspector.

Regulation 6 increases the amount of dog handlers’ allowances from £468 to £492 and from £633 to £666.
