The Merchant Shipping (Distress Signals and Prevention of Collisions) (Overseas Territories) (Amendment) Order 1984

The Queen's Most Excellent Majesty in Council

Her Majesty, in exercise of the powers conferred upon Her by section 47(1) of the Merchant Shipping Act 1979(a), is pleased, by and with the advice of Her Privy Council, to order, and it is hereby ordered, as follows:

1. This Order may be cited as the Merchant Shipping (Distress Signals and Prevention of Collisions) (Overseas Territories) (Amendment) Order 1984 and shall come into operation on 1st December 1984.

2. The Merchant Shipping (Distress Signals and Prevention of Collisions) (Overseas Territories) Order 1983(b) is hereby amended by:

- (i) adding Bermuda to the list of territories specified in Schedule 1 to the said Order; and
- (ii) adding, at the end of footnote (b) relating to Regulation 1(5)(b) in Schedule 2 to the said Order, the words "and to Bermuda by S.I. 1974/2148".
