LEGAL AID AND ADVICE, ENGLAND AND WALES

The Legal Aid in Criminal Proceedings (General) (Amendment) Regulations 1984

Made - - - 22nd October 1984

Laid before Parliament 2nd November 1984

Coming into Operation 26th November 1984

The Lord Chancellor, in exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 39 of the Legal Aid Act 1974(a), and now vested in him(b), and section 7 of the Legal Aid Act 1982(c) and with the concurrence of the Treasury, hereby makes the following Regulations:—

- 1. These Regulations may be cited as the Legal Aid in Criminal Proceedings (General) (Amendment) Regulations 1984 and shall come into operation on 26th November 1984.
- 2. In the Legal Aid in Criminal Proceedings (General) Regulations 1968(d)
 - (a) for the weekly sum of £42 specified in regulation 19(3) (a), there shall be substituted the weekly sum of £44; and
 - (b) for the sums specified in the Third Schedule, there shall be substituted the following sums:—

Exceeding £44 but not exceeding £50 £1
Exceeding £50 but not exceeding £54 £2
Exceeding £54 but not exceeding £58 £3
Exceeding £58 but not exceeding £62 £4
Exceeding £62 but not exceeding £66 £5,

and the weekly instalment of contribution shall be increased by £1 for each £4 or part of £4 by which average weekly disposable income exceeds £66.

These Regulations increase from £42 to £44 a week the disposable income above which a person receiving legal aid in criminal proceedings under Part II of the Legal Aid Act 1974 is required, under the Legal Aid Act 1982, to pay a contribution and amend the scale of contributions.
