**The Education (Grants for In-service Training of Teachers)
(Scotland) Amendment Regulations 1984**

<i>Made - - - -</i>	31st October 1984
<i>Laid before Parliament</i>	15th November 1984
<i>Coming into Operation</i>	6th December 1984

In exercise of the powers conferred on me by sections 73(a) and 74(1) of the Education (Scotland) Act 1980(a), and all other powers enabling me in that behalf, I hereby make the following regulations:—

Citation and commencement

1. These regulations may be cited as the Education (Grants for In-service Training of Teachers) (Scotland) Amendment Regulations 1984 and shall come into operation on 6th December 1984.

Interpretation

2. In these regulations a reference to the principal regulations is a reference to the Education (Grants for In-service Training of Teachers) (Scotland) Regulations 1984(b).

Amendment of principal regulations

3. For the Schedule to the principal regulations (Subject areas in respect of which grants may be paid) there shall be substituted the Schedule to these regulations.

SUBJECT AREAS IN RESPECT OF WHICH GRANTS MAY BE PAID

Primary education

Environmental studies
Expressive arts
Organisation for learning and teaching

Primary and Secondary education

Curriculum liaison
Language and learning for pupils aged 10 to 14
Management of staff development
Writing course modules in physical education

Secondary education

Electronics and micro-electronics
Construction and processing of criterion-referenced assessment
Home economics: priorities in management
Resource based learning
Social subjects in the common course in years 1 and 2 of the secondary school

Special education

Continuing education for young people with special educational needs
Curriculum for young people with severe mental handicap

General

Courses in management for promoted staff in schools
Courses in use of microcomputers.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Regulations.)

These regulations amend the Education (Grants for In-service Training of Teachers) (Scotland) Regulations 1984 by substituting a new Schedule to the regulations. The regulations permit the payment to education authorities of grants in respect of teachers undergoing in-service training in the subject areas listed in the Schedule and the amending regulations add three subject areas:— Management of staff development and Writing course modules in physical education for Primary and Secondary education and Curriculum for young people with severe mental handicap for Special education.
