**The Goods Vehicles (Plating and Testing) (Amendment)
Regulations 1984**

The Secretary of State for Transport, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 45(1) and (6) of the Road Traffic Act 1972 (a) and now vested in him (b), and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with representative organisations in accordance with the provisions of section 199(2) of that Act, hereby makes the following Regulations:—

1. The Regulations may be cited as the Goods Vehicles (Plating and Testing) (Amendment) Regulations 1984 and shall come into operation on 1st June 1984.

2. The Goods Vehicles (Plating and Testing) Regulations 1982 (c) are hereby amended so that for paragraph 20 of Schedule 2 there is substituted the following paragraphs:—

“20. Public service vehicles (as defined in section 1 of the Public Passenger Vehicles Act 1981 (d)).

20A. Hackney carriages (as defined in section 38(1) of the Vehicles (Excise) Act 1971 (e)).”.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Regulations.)

These Regulations amend the Goods Vehicles (Plating and Testing) Regulations 1982 so as to avoid a reference to public service vehicles and hackney carriages becoming obsolete in consequence of the Goods Vehicles (Operators' Licences, Qualifications and Fees) Regulations 1984 (S.I. 1984/176).
