**The Local Statutory Provisions (Postponement of Repeal)
(Scotland) Order 1984**

In exercise of the powers conferred on me by section 225(6)(b) of the Local Government (Scotland) Act 1973(a) and of all other powers enabling me in that behalf, I hereby make the following Order:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Local Statutory Provisions (Postponement of Repeal) (Scotland) Order 1984 and shall come into operation on 31st December 1984.

2. The date on which all local statutory provisions applying to the whole or any part of the local government areas specified in the Schedule to this Order, so far as they so apply, are to cease to have effect is hereby postponed to 31st December 1985.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Order.)

Section 225(6) of the Local Government (Scotland) Act 1973 provides that all local statutory provisions to which the subsection applies shall cease to have effect at the end of 1984. This Order postpones until the end of 1985 the date on which all local statutory provisions applying to the local government areas or parts thereof listed in the Schedule are to cease to have effect.
