INTERNATIONAL IMMUNITIES AND PRIVILEGES

**The Commonwealth Countries and Republic of Ireland
(Immunities and Privileges) (Amendment) Order 1984**

Made - - - - 19th December 1984

Laid before Parliament 8th January 1985

Coming into Operation 30th January 1985

At the Court at Buckingham Palace, the 19th day of December 1984

Present,

The Queen's Most Excellent Majesty in Council

Her Majesty, by virtue and in exercise of the powers conferred on Her by sections 12 and 14 of the Consular Relations Act 1968(a), or otherwise in Her Majesty vested, is pleased, by and with the advice of Her Privy Council, to order, and it is hereby ordered, as follows:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Commonwealth Countries and Republic of Ireland (Immunities and Privileges) (Amendment) Order 1984 and shall come into operation on 30th January 1985.

2. Schedule 1 to the Commonwealth Countries and Republic of Ireland (Immunities and Privileges) Order 1971(b) (hereinafter referred to as the Order) shall be amended as follows:

- (a) the entry
“Malawi
The Chief Agent, London”
shall be deleted; and
- (b) for the entry “Assistant Commissioners for Bangladesh” there shall be substituted “Assistant High Commissioners for Bangladesh”.

3. In Schedule 2 to the Order for the entry
“Cyprus
The Honorary Commissioner, Glasgow”
shall be substituted the entry
“Cyprus
The Honorary Commissioner, Birmingham
The Honorary Commissioner, Bristol
The Honorary Commissioner, Glasgow
The Honorary Commissioner, Manchester”.

4. Article 8A of the Order shall be amended by adding at the end the words
“and to the office and the residence respectively of the Falkland Islands
Government Representative in London.”.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Order.)

This Order further amends the Commonwealth Countries and Republic of Ireland (Immunities and Privileges) Order 1971 by making its provisions no longer applicable to the Chief Agent for Malawi, which office has ceased to exist. It also takes account of the new designation of the former Assistant Commissioners for Bangladesh, and makes provision for new Honorary Commissioners for Cyprus. Finally, it extends partial relief from general rates to the office and residence of the Falkland Islands Government Representative in London.
