The Consular Fees (Amendment No. 3) Order 1984

 Coming into Operation 1st January 1985

Present,

The Queen's Most Excellent Majesty in Council

Her Majesty, in exercise of the power conferred upon Her by section 1(1) of the Consular Fees Act 1980 (a), is pleased, by and with the advice of Her Privy Council, to order, and it is hereby ordered, as follows:—

1. This Order shall come into operation on 1st January 1985 and may be cited as the Consular Fees (Amendment No. 3) Order 1984.

2. Part II of the table of consular fees in the Schedule annexed to the Consular Fees Order 1983 (b), as amended by the Consular Fees (Amendment No. 2) Order 1984 (c), shall be amended by substituting for Fee 22 the following:—

“22 Granting a visa, entry certificate or entry permit—	£
for an ordinary visa, entry certificate or entry permit	10.00
for a transit visa, entry certificate or permit	8.00
for a multiple entry visa, entry certificate or permit	20.00
or for any visa, entry certificate or entry permit such sums, being the equivalents of fees charged by the authorities of any State for granting a visa, entry certificate or entry permit to a British citizen, as the Secretary of State, with the consent of the Treasury, directs to be taken for granting a visa, entry certificate or entry permit to a national or citizen of that State	
except where a United Kingdom visa is issued on a foreign passport held by a person who is a British citizen”.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Order.)

This Order amends the Consular Fees Order 1983 so as to introduce as from 1st January 1985 a fee for issuing an entry certificate. The Order also removes the exemption from paying a fee for a United Kingdom visa in cases where such a visa is issued on a foreign passport held by a person who is a British Dependent Territories citizen, British Overseas citizen or British Protected person.
