## BUILDING SOCIETIES

## The Building Societies (Fees) Regulations 1984

The Chief Registrar of Friendly Societies, with the consent of the Treasury, pursuant to the powers conferred upon him by section 123(1) of the Building Societies Act 1962(a), and to all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following Regulations:—

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Building Societies (Fees) Regulations 1984 and shall come into operation on 1st April 1984.

2. The Building Societies (Forms and Fees) Regulations 1962(b) shall be amended as follows:

(a) by substituting for regulation 3 the following regulation:

“3. Fees in respect of the matters set out in the first column of Schedule 2 shall be payable in advance to the Central Office. The amount of the fee in each case shall be the corresponding amount in the second column of that Schedule.”

(b) by substituting for Schedule 2 thereto the following Schedule:—

3. The Building Societies (Fees) Regulations 1983(a) are hereby revoked.

#### EXPLANATORY NOTE

*(This Note is not part of the Regulations.)*

These Regulations increase by about 15% the fees payable in connection with the exercise by the Central Office and the Chief Registrar of their functions under the Building Societies Act 1962. These Regulations supersede the Building Societies (Fees) Regulations 1983. They also make a drafting amendment to the Building Societies (Forms and Fees) Regulations 1962 consistent with the amended format of the substituted Schedule 2.
