The Grant-Aided Secondary Schools (Scotland) Grant Amendment Regulations 1984

In exercise of the powers conferred on me by section 73(c) of the Education (Scotland) Act 1980(a), and of all other powers enabling me in that behalf, I hereby make the following regulations:—

Citation and commencement

1. These regulations may be cited as the Grant-Aided Secondary Schools (Scotland) Grant Amendment Regulations 1984 and shall come into operation on 1st July 1984.

Interpretation

2. In these regulations, a reference to the principal regulations is a reference to the Grant-Aided Secondary Schools (Scotland) Grant Regulations 1976(b).

Amendment of the Grant-Aided Secondary Schools (Scotland) Grant Regulations 1976

- 3. The principal regulations shall be amended as follows:—
 - (1) for the definition of "financial year" there shall be substituted the following definition:—
 - "'financial year' in relation to a specified school means, subject to regulation 15 of these regulations, any period of twelve months to which the accounts of that school relate, beginning after 30th June 1984 and ending in the calendar year 1985";
 - (2) for Schedule 1, there shall be substituted the following Schedule:—

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Regulations.)

These Regulations further amend the Grant-Aided Secondary Schools (Scotland) Grant Regulations 1976 (the principal regulations) so as to extend their general operation to the financial year of grant-aided secondary schools ending in 1985.

Regulation 3(1) redefines "financial year" to enable a further financial year to be taken into account for the purposes of payment of grant under the principal regulations.

Regulation 3(2) substitutes a revised Schedule 1 stating revised amounts for the purposes of calculation of maintenance grant awarded to each school or group of schools listed therein for the financial year ending in 1985.
