# The Gaming (Small Charges) (Scotland) Amendment Order 1984

Made - - 29th March 1984

Laid before Parliament 9th April 1984

Coming into Operation 30th April 1984

In exercise of the powers conferred on me by sections 40(2) and 51(4) of the Gaming Act 1968(a), and of all other powers enabling me in that behalf, I hereby make the following order:—

- 1.—(1) This order may be cited as the Gaming (Small Charges) (Scotland) Amendment Order 1984 and shall come into operation on 30th April 1984.
  - (2) This order shall extend to Scotland only.
- 2. Article 3(b) of the Gaming (Small Charges) (Scotland) Order 1975(b) shall be amended by substituting for the words "the sum of 15p" the words "the sum of 25p".
- 3. The Gaming (Small Charges) (Scotland) Amendment Order 1981(c) is hereby revoked.
