TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING, ENGLAND AND WALES

The Town and Country Planning (Structure and Local Plans) (Amendment) Regulations 1984

Made	6th January 1984
Laid before Parliament	17th January 1984
Coming into Operation	8th February 1984

The Secretary of State for the Environment, in exercise of the powers conferred on him by sections 7(1A), (6) and (6A), 8(1), (2) and (3), 9(3)(a), 18(1) and (2) and 287 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1971(a), and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following regulations:-

Citation and commencement

1. These regulations may be cited as the Town and Country Planning (Structure and Local Plans) (Amendment) Regulations 1984 and shall come into operation on 8th February 1984.

Amendment of the 1982 regulations

2. The following regulation shall be substituted for regulation 1 of the Town and Country Planning (Structure and Local Plans) Regulations 1982 (b):-

"Application

- 1.—(1) Subject to paragraph (2) of this regulation, these regulations shall extend throughout England and Wales.
- The provisions of Parts V, VI and VIII and regulation 19 shall not extend to Greater London, and the provisions of Part II, Parts IX to XII and the Schedule shall extend to Greater London only insofar as they relate to structure plans.
- (3) In their application to Greater London, references in these regulations to a county planning authority shall be construed as references to the Greater London Council, and references to a district planning authority shall be construed as references to a London borough council or the Common Council of the City of London, as the case may be.".

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Regulations.)

These regulations amend the Town and Country Planning (Structure and Local Plans) Regulations 1982, which prescribe the form and content of structure and local plans outside Greater London and the procedure to be followed in connection with their preparation, submission, approval or adoption and their alteration or repeal and replacement. The provisions of the 1982 regulations which relate to structure plans are extended to Greater London, with appropriate adaptations.

The structure plan for Greater London is, by virtue of paragraph 5 of Schedule 4 to the Town and Country Planning Act 1971, the Greater London development plan.

Provision in relation to local plans in Greater London has already been made by the Town and Country Planning (Local Plans for Greater London) Regulations 1983 (S.I. 1983/1190).
