
(A) LENGTH OF WATERCOURSE TO BE DIVERTED

The length of watercourse to be diverted is the Stratford-upon-Avon Canal between a point approximately 209 metres (228 yards) north-west of the existing Bishopton Lane road bridge over that Canal and a point approximately 259 metres (283 yards) northwest of the same road bridge all in the Parish of Old Stratford and Drayton in the County of Warwickshire. The north-east and south-west banks of the Canal shall both be extended over the existing bed of the Canal to a maximum width of 4 metres (13 feet) in each case along a length of 50 metres (55 yards) leaving a minimum reduced width of waterway of 2.75 metres (3 yards) with a minimum depth of 1.3 metres (4 feet 3 inches) throughout such length. On the location plan to this Schedule this length is shown in outline together with the width of the Canal to be so reduced, which is marked "new length", and the banks of the Canal to be so extended, which are hatched.


(B) LENGTH OF TOWING PATH TO BE DIVERTED AND NEW LENGTH TO BE PROVIDED


The length of towing path to be diverted is a length adjacent to and on the north side of the length of watercourse to be diverted described in paragraph (A) of this Schedule and is shown by zebra hatching on the detailed layout plan to this Schedule. The route of the new length of towing path is adjacent to and south of the length of towing path to be diverted previously described and is shown by stipple on the detailed layout plan to this Schedule and its centre line is marked by a black band

STRATFORD-UPON-AVON CANAL BRIDGE




LOCATION PLAN - SCALE 1:2500



SCHEDULE 1

ROUTE OF THE NEW TRUNK ROAD

The route of the new trunk road is a route at Stratford-upon-Avon in the county of Warwickshire about 8.5 kilometres (5.3 miles) in length, starting at a point on the A422 Alcester Road, (where it forms a roundabout), about 350 metres (383 yards) west of its inter-section with The Ridgeway north-west of Shottery then going north of Bishopton to connect with a roundabout proposed to be constructed as an improvement to the A34 Trunk Road and then proceeding in a generally north-easterly direction south of Snitterfield and terminating at a roundabout proposed to be constructed as an improvement to the A46 Trunk Road at its junction with King's Lane at Marraway.

The Secretary of State for Transport makes this order in exercise of powers conferred by sections 10, 41, 106 and 108 of the Highways Act 1980(a) and now vested in him(b) and of all other enabling powers:—

- 1. The new highway which the Secretary of State proposes to construct along the route described in Schedule 1 to this order shall become a trunk road as from the date when this order comes into operation.
- 2. The centre line of the new trunk road is indicated by a heavy black line on the deposited plan.
- 3. The Secretary of State directs as respects any part of a highway which crosses the route of the new trunk road that-
 - (a) where the highway is a highway maintainable at the public expense by a local highway authority, the part in question shall be maintained by that authority, and
 - (b) where the highway is not a highway so maintainable and is not maintainable under a special enactment or by reason of tenure, enclosure or prescription, the Secretary of State shall be under no duty to maintain the part in question.

until, in either case, a date to be specified in a notice given by the Secretary of State to the highway authority for that highway. The date specified will not be later than the date on which the relevant route is opened for the purposes of through traffic.

4. The Secretary of State is authorised to construct the bridge specified in Schedule 2 to this order as part of the new trunk road referred to in Schedule 1 to this order and, in connection with the construction of that bridge, to divert the part of the navigable watercourse specified in the said Schedule 2 and the towing paths adjacent to that part in the manner shown in that Schedule.
