(Kingston upon Hull) Order 1984**

Whereas the Secretary of State has granted to the Kingston upon Hull City Council a licence ("the Licence") under section 7 of the Telecommunications Act 1984(a) ("the Act"), to which section 8 of the Act applies, for the running of the telecommunication systems specified in Annex A to the Licence ("the Applicable Systems"):

Now, therefore, the Secretary of State in exercise of the powers conferred on him by sections 9 and 104 of the Act and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Public Telecommunication System Designation (Kingston upon Hull) Order 1984 and shall come into operation on 5th August 1984.

2. Each of the Applicable Systems is hereby designated as a public telecommunication system.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Order.)

The Secretary of State granted to the Kingston upon Hull City Council on 25th June 1984 a licence under section 7 of the Telecommunications Act 1984 to run the telecommunication systems specified in Annex A to that licence in the Hull area. This Order designates those telecommunication systems as public telecommunication systems. Consequently, by virtue of section 9(3) of that Act, the Kingston upon Hull City Council is a public telecommunications operator.
