EDUCATION, ENGLAND AND WALES

The Education Support Grants (Amendment) Regulations 1985

Laid before Parliament in draft

Made - - - - - *10th July 1985*

Coming into Operation *1st September 1985*

In exercise of the powers conferred upon the Secretary of State by section 1(2) of the Education (Grants and Awards) Act 1984(a) and after consulting, in accordance with section 3(5) of that Act, such bodies representing local education authorities as appear to them to be appropriate, the Secretary of State for Education and Science, as respects England, and the Secretary of State for Wales, as respects Wales, hereby make the following Regulations, a draft of which has been laid before Parliament and has been approved by resolution of each House of Parliament:—

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Education Support Grants (Amendment) Regulations 1985 and shall come into operation on 1st September 1985.

2. The Schedule to the Education Support Grants Regulations 1984(b) (which specifies the purposes for or in connection with which education support grants are payable) shall be amended as follows:—

(1) In item 3 there shall be inserted after the word “science” the words “and technology”.

(2) In item 8 there shall be inserted after the word “needs” the words “(including the need for guidance)”.

(3) After item 8 there shall be added the following additional item:—

“8A. Where provision to meet the need of the unemployed for educational guidance is being planned, developed and co-ordinated the planning, development and co-ordination of the provision of such guidance for other adult persons.”.

- (4) After item 10 there shall be added the following additional items:—
- “11. The development, provision and appraisal of courses of initial training for school governors.
 12. The provision of support for parents in the teaching of children under the age of 5 with special educational needs.
 13. The provision of computerised learning aids and associated software at further education establishments for use by students with special educational needs.
 14. The employment of staff to strengthen links between further education establishments and employers in order to improve the quality and relevance of further education courses.
 15. Combatting, through education, the misuse of drugs.”.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Regulations.)

These Regulations amend the Education Support Grants Regulations 1984. Item 3 of the Schedule has been expanded to include technology and item 8 has been amended to refer expressly to the need for guidance. Six new purposes have been added to the Schedule as item 8A and items 11-15.
