CUSTOMS AND EXCISE
The Export of Goods (Control) (Amendment) Order 1985

<i>Made - - - -</i>	<i>15th July 1985</i>
<i>Coming into Operation</i>	<i>25th July 1985</i>

The Secretary of State, in exercise of powers conferred by section 1 of the Import, Export and Customs Powers (Defence) Act 1939(a) and now vested in him(b), and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order:

1. This Order may be cited as the Export of Goods (Control) (Amendment) Order 1985 and shall come into operation on 25th July 1985.

2. The Export of Goods (Control) Order 1985(c) shall be amended as follows:

(a) in Group 3D of Part II of Schedule 1—

(i) in entry IL1305 (Metal rolling mills), for “IL1305 (*cont.*)” there shall be substituted for “IL1306 (*cont.*)”

(ii) in entry IL1355, after head (10), there shall be inserted the following additional head:

“(11) Software for the design of semi-conductor devices or microcircuits which—

(i) performs any of the functions in sub-head 3(c) above A

(ii) can be used for transient analysis A

(iii) can be used for logic analysis or logic checking A

(iv) can be used for automatic routing or cell placement A

(v) can be used for the generation of test vectors A

(vi) can be used for process simulation A”

(b) in Group 3E of Part II of Schedule 1, in entry IL 1416 (Ships, surface-effect vehicles, water-screw propellers and specially designed components)—

(i) after head (5) there shall be inserted the following additional head:

(a) 1939 c. 69.

(b) See S.I. 1970/1537.

(c) S.I. 1985/849.

“(5A) Surface-effect vehicles, namely hovercraft, air cushion vehicles of both the sidewall and skirted varieties and all variations of vehicles using the wing-in-ground effect for positive liftA”

(ii) in head (6), for the words “(1) to (5)” there shall be substituted “(1) to (5A)”;

(c) in Group 4 of Part II of Schedule 1, the first entry (The process of inert gas and vacuum atomising for achieving sphericity and uniform size of particles in metal powders) shall be deleted and the following entry shall be inserted after entry IL1567 (Technology applicable to the development, production or installation, operation and maintenance of stored-programme-controlled communication switching equipment or systems)—

“IL 1601 The process of inert gas and vacuum atomising for achieving sphericity and uniform size of particles in metal powders.”

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Order.)

This Order amends the Export of Goods (Control) Order 1985. It extends the scope of that Order by prohibiting the export of surface-effect vehicles (including hovercraft) and software for the design of semi-conductor devices or microcircuits. In addition it makes two minor changes relating to the classification system used in Part II of Schedule 1 to the Order.
