**The Lower Swansea Valley Enterprise Zone (No. 2) Designation
Order 1985**

Whereas by a resolution dated 29th November 1984 the Swansea City Council adopted the Lower Swansea Valley Enterprise Zone (No. 2) Scheme;

And whereas an advertisement in accordance with the requirements of paragraph 3(7) and (8) of Schedule 32 to the Local Government, Planning and Land Act 1980(a) was published in the London Gazette and the South Wales Evening Post;

And whereas six weeks have expired since the date of the first publication of the said advertisement and no application has been made to the High Court;

Now, therefore, the Secretary of State for Wales, in exercise of the powers conferred on him by Section 179 of, and paragraph 5 of Schedule 32 to, the Local Government, Planning and Land Act 1980, and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, and with the consent of the Treasury, hereby makes the following Order:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Lower Swansea Valley Enterprise Zone (No. 2) Designation Order 1985 and shall come into operation on 6th March 1985.

2. In this Order “the deposited map” means the map marked “map referred to in the Lower Swansea Valley Enterprise Zone (No. 2) Designation Order 1985”, of which one print, signed by an Assistant Secretary in the Welsh Office, has been deposited and is available for inspection at each of the following offices, that is to say, the principal offices of the Swansea City Council and the principal offices of the Secretary of State for Wales in Cardiff.

3. The area to which the Lower Swansea Valley Enterprise Zone (No. 2) Scheme relates and which is shown on the deposited map is hereby designated as an enterprise zone.

4.—(1) The boundary of the enterprise zone is shown by a heavy black line edged internally with a stippled band on the deposited map.

(a) 1980 c. 65.

(2) The date when the designation takes effect is the date of the coming into operation of this Order.

(3) The period for which the area is to remain an enterprise zone is a period of ten years from the date when the designation takes effect.

(4) Swansea City Council is hereby designated as the enterprise zone authority for the Lower Swansea Valley Enterprise Zone (No. 2).

EXPLANATORY NOTE

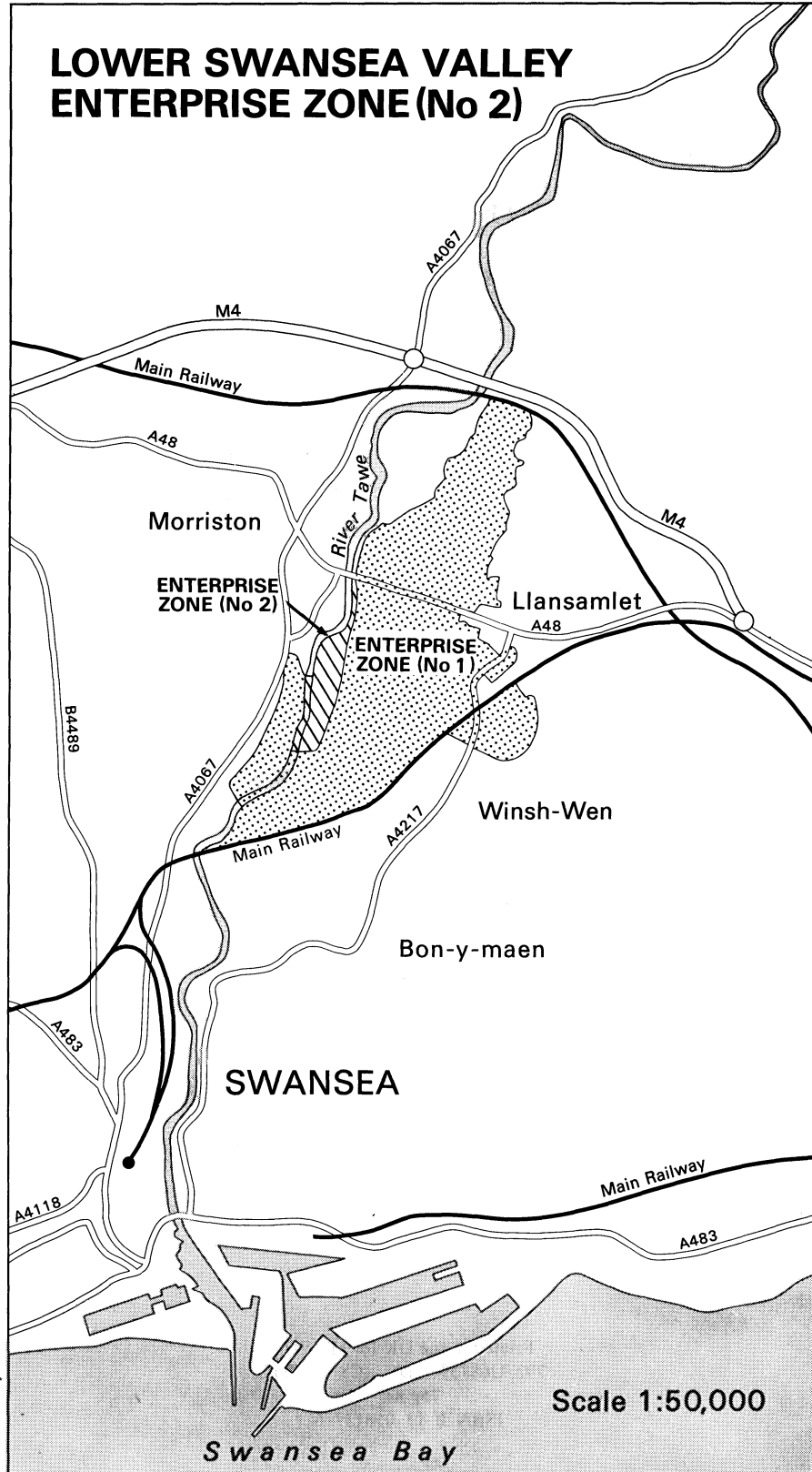
(This Note is not part of the Order.)

This Order designates as an enterprise zone the area of the Lower Swansea Valley Enterprise Zone (No. 2) Scheme which was adopted by the Swansea City Council on 29th November 1984. The designation is effective for a period of 10 years.
